CANINE REGISTRATION FORM

Allegretto Vineyard Resort is pleased to welcome you and your canine.

In an effort to ensure the peace and tranquility of all guests, we ask for your commitment to the following:

- Pets must be leashed at all times while about the property.
- Pet(s) must be removed from the guestroom for housekeeping to freshen the room during your stay, or owner(s) must be present at the time of housekeeping service.
- No more than two canines may occupy a guestroom at any time.
- Owner's responsibilities will include interruption of activities to attend to a barking dog that may be disrupting other guests.

Dogs are restricted from the following areas of the resort:

- Fitness Center
- Spa at Allegretto
- Pool & Cabana
- Cello Restaurant (This includes All indoor and outdoor seating areas of the restaurant, with the exception of the two tables on the south side of the outside seating area. These seats are available only when offering outside food & beverage services).

The following fees and/or charges will apply:

- A \$100 one-time fee will be automatically charged to your account. For periods in excess of 7-days, additional fees will apply.
- In the event of any damage to the room caused by your pet, the cost of repair will be charged to your account.
- You will assume responsible for any compensation or reimbursement provided to another guest staying on property brought about by the disturbance caused by your canine. Such compensation will be charged to your account.

The owner/caretaker of the canine represents to Allegretto Vineyard Resort that the pet of registration is not inclined to bite. In the event the dog does bite or cause injury while on the Resort's premises, the owner/caretaker agrees to release, defend, and indemnify Allegretto Vineyard Resort and Ayres Hotels from any liability the Resort may incur, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney fees related to such dog bites, injuries or damages.

You expressly waive and relinquish benefits of California Civil Code Section 1542, which provides: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor."
